Dear Parents and Carers of Year 4

We have been very lucky to receive money from the School Association to buy musical instruments. We have purchased class sets of recorders and ukuleles and it is now the turn of Year 4 to start learning to play the recorder. They will be doing so for the next few weeks.

These recorders belong to school and are for the use of all children in turn but, while your children are learning, they may take the instruments home in order to practise. I will, however, need the form below to be completed before your child can take a recorder home. In the event of the instrument being damaged or lost, you will need to recompense the school so that we can buy another (see below for the cost.)

Recorders **must** be back in school each Wednesday for our lessons. We do not have spares, so if anyone forgets, they will only be able to observe the lesson.

The book we are using is called "Recorder from the beginning" by John Pitts. If you wish to purchase a copy for use at home it is available from St Giles Music in Northampton at a cost of £4.99. This is **not a requirement for lessons**, it is entirely optional.
