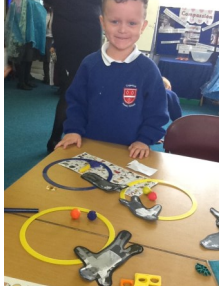
In Maths we have been learning about sharing equally. We even challenged the

to out irregular quantities.

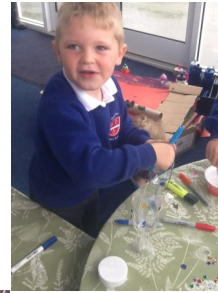
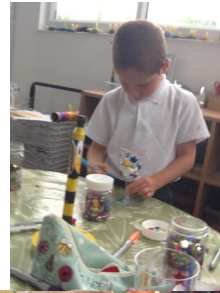


'Royalty'
