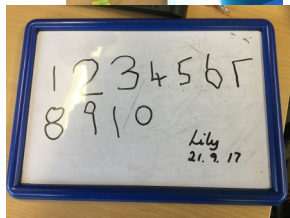
Thursday 4th—library book bags and p.e kit for first full changing.
